Daylily plants are available for transplanting into your home gardens. Several plant pots have been placed near “Karen’s Prairie Mound” in the front of the old tennis court area. These daylilies are “double orange” and grow to a height of about 3 feet and will spread. If planted in the spring, they should bloom during this summer.
