

# RULES REGARDING GARDEN FENCES

The growing season in our area varies greatly for many varieties of plants. Fences may remain in place as long as the protection of seasonal plants is warranted.

Fenced gardens must be contiguous bed areas.

The garden fence must be see-through and not be considered a privacy or boundary fence

The total height of the fence must be no more than 8 feet

The distance from the property line must not interfere with easements

The fence distance from the edge of the garden bed must be no further than 3 feet on all sides

Fence materials may be:

- Chicken wire or metal mesh of a green, brown, or black color
- Poly mesh (like bird netting)
- No chain-link, no snow fence, no safety fence, no wood or vinyl pickets or rails;
